General Comments					
A Monitoring Inspection occurred on July 29, 2025.					
Children were observed during indoor free play and snack. Proper handwashing was noted during snack time. Steps or platforms are available to help children access regular-sized toilets and sinks independently.					
The Operator stated that the children are currently very engaged in a plant market stand, growing sprouts, a bird inquiry incorporating Indigenous perspectives, sunflower exploration, and active play in the new outdoor play area. Positive child guidance techniques were observed, and the Operator was seen actively participating in the children's activities.					

Parents of children present at the centre are granted access at any time. Rest periods are individualized and do not exceed two consecutive hours. Snacks are provided at intervals no longer than three hours, and meals are served during recognized meal periods. A daily routine is visibly posted.

Evacuation procedures are posted in a prominent location. The room is set up in an inviting manner, with materials arranged to encourage child-led play. Ideas from the web and learning stories are reflected throughout the art area, library, kitchen, and dramatic play zones.

Any food brought from home is clearly labelled with the child's name. Drinking water is available throughout the day. Infant bottles are labelled and used only for the intended child. Several forms of documentation were visible throughout the facility, showcasing ongoing learning and exploration.

The Operator provides opportunities for curriculum to be extended outdoors and makes efforts to bring the natural world into the indoor environment. Webs have been completed with the children and expanded upon by the Operator to support an engaging and responsive learning environment.
