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General Comments

Licensing staff arrived to conduct a monitoring visit. It was a beautiful morning, and the infants were outside in their play area with their educators. The outdoor infant play area is well set up, and it has lots of shade and a grassy surface as well as a paved area to ride their child sized ride on vehicles. There is a picnic table and a wooden obstacle course, a wooden house and wooden car as well as a storage chest for a variety of materials. The educators were very attentive, and they made sure that the children had water, hats and sunscreen. They played with the children and spoke kindly to them and helped them use their words and add new words to their vocabularies. After outside play the infants played inside, were diapered and had their lunches and naps.

The 2-year-old group was inside, and they had circle and snack and were playing at the different stations until it was their turn to play outside. They use the infant play area and take turns with that space. All snacks and lunches are brought from home. The children and educators had made a web about camping, and they were learning new words about this as well as discussing their vacations. The room has a ball pit, an ice cream station, lots of interesting loose parts, labelled baskets with dress up materials etc. and a market with a calculator as well as cooking utensils and wooden food. All the 2-year-olds napped.

The older mixed age group played outside for most of the morning. Their play area had multiple surfaces as well, with grass, pea gravel and a sand box. They have really good shade and a pergola made from wood that had picnic tables and a mud kitchen, water table and storage chest. The educators set up an invitation to play at the mud kitchen and got out the hose for water play. The children really loved the water play and they had a really good time running through the spray. Lunch was outside and then everyone came into nap.

The necessary postings were on the parent board and all the staff information was up to date as were the attendance sheets and daily infant record checks. The educators were kind and patient and only positive child guidance was observed.
