Comments: There are small objects (corks, wooden pebbles) in the loose part section of the play area that can be a choking hazard to an infant. Storage solutions such as closed bins and putting objects higher were discussed. These objects are to be out of reach of the infant but available to older children.

<p>A mid-morning visit was made to the ELC home.</p> <p>The following administrative records are maintained on site: Financial records, daily attendance of children and staff, monthly emergency evacuation fire drills, smoke alarm, smoke detectors and fire extinguisher inspection and maintenance records.</p> <p>All required documents are to be maintained for a year. All required documents are to be maintained for three years after a child has left the facility.</p> <p>Operator has installed a new play set in the outdoor play area. Discussion was had in regard to protective surfacing. It is recommended that operator ensure that the play structure is installed as per Manufacturer's instructions. Operator will ensure that the children are not utilizing the play set until the Manufacturer's instructions have been reviewed.</p> <p>At time of my visit, the children came in from outside, washed their hands and had a snack. The infant had a nap while the preschool children played in free play.</p>
