<p>General Comments</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Mid-day visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection -Ratio was respected during the visit -A first-aid kit and a telephone are available on-site, as well as during excursions outside of the daycare premises. -Outdoor play area needs to consist of more than one surface to permit different types of play, operator confirms that she has bags of sand and will fill the turtle sand box. -Outdoor material is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present -Outdoor play area must be maintained safe and free of hazards; garbage bags and a small bar-b-q filled with charcoal's needs to be put away and out of reach of the children. -Mulch needs to be added under the play structure in the outside playground, bags of mulch are bought it only needs to be spread under the structure. -Pictures will be sent showing compliance of the outside space -During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations. -Children's indoor play area is safe and clean. - Material and equipment proposed to children in the indoor play area are easily accessible on low, open

shelves. It is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present.

-It was noticed that the operator started binders storing the children's documentation. It was discussed that learning stories and documentation showing the children's learning will be expected since the operator's is almost done with her 90 hours.

Observations: When arriving at the center, children were finishing their lunch and were getting ready for a nap, they all got up and played a little bit more before going down for nap. One new friend arrived just before I was leaving.
