**General Comments**

Children were finishing up outdoor play when licensing staff arrived. The operator mentioned they were returning inside earlier than usual due to a wasp's nest just built in the outdoor play area. The operator is going to ensure it is removed and safe for children's play by tomorrow. Children moved to the play area when they came inside, and the operator offered markers and paper to the children, placing them on the small table. Children moved around the room drawing and seeking out books to read. The operator asked children if they wanted to hear the newer book they had received. Children sat around the operator while she read the title and author and asked questions as they read the book.

After reading, the operator began asking children if they needed to use the washroom and to wash their hands in preparation for lunch. Children continued to play bringing vehicles to the licensing staff to join in. One child cleaned the smaller table for lunch and individual plates were placed for each child. One child wanted to use the blue chair and was attempting to remove a child when the operator intervened and stated that a child already had the chair and maybe they could use it later or tomorrow for lunch.

There was a learning story posted on the posted board and the operator mentioned that due to printer issues, they have been posting more online for parents to view. Encouragement was given by licensing staff to post various forms of documentation throughout the space such as photos, children's names, labels on resources, and children's artifacts. A visual schedule was suggested to help children recognize the predictability of the day and nurture children's working memory.
