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General Comments - Visit completed at the establishment in the mid-morning for a monitoring inspection. - During the visit, the ratio was respected. - Posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility are the following documents: The licence, inspection report, daily routine, evacuation procedures, name of administrator, name and telephone number of QA Monitor and inspector - Life threatening allergies and when it applies a notice to inform parents of the existence of a communicable disease. - A daily incident log is maintained; parents are informed and sign the daily log. - Incident report forms are completed and signed by the parent when a reportable incident occurs. The report is sent to the Department within 24 hours of the incident, and a copy is provided to the parent. Incident reports are kept in the child's file. - Each napping child has a cot that is appropriate for their height. - There is a space of at least 46 cm between rest equipment, and all nap equipment is washable and non-absorbent. - Outdoor materials are varied and available in sufficient quantity for all children present. - The outdoor play area is maintained in safe conditions. The administrator confirms that the stationary equipment is surrounded by the appropriate depth of protective surfacing and has been installed according to the manufacturer's instructions. - Observations: - Preschool group: Lunch and naptime were observed and parent arrival. - After schoolers: The children ate the lunch provided by their parents and then went outside to play. - Discussion with the director concerning the outdoor play space. There is a plan in place to improve the outdoor play space.
