Comments: Monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills were observed and are up to date. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments
<p>A monitoring inspection occurred in the afternoon.</p> <p>School-Age: The children were observed engaged in a variety of activities, including cutting straws with scissors, reading books, building robots out of recycled materials, and completing sticker books. Additionally, the children were observed eating snack with hand washing occurring beforehand. Today's snack consisted of crackers, mango pieces, and water.</p> <p>The educators indicated that the children are currently interested in dancing and music, building obstacle courses in the gym, planting, sticker books, and participating in Baking Day Fridays.</p> <p>The room is well-organized and inviting, offering a varied supply of age-appropriate materials, books, and toys. Traffic areas are kept clean, and outdoor walkways are free of clutter. Toxic products such as cleaning agents are securely locked and inaccessible to children.</p> <p>Positive child guidance techniques were observed. The educators were observed to be engaging at the children's level, providing appropriate supervision, using encouraging language, offering choices, and assisting children with decision-making.</p>

General Comments

A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for the posting of the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents reviewed included incident logs, daily attendance records, four educator files and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.
