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General Comments

Renewal Inspection:

A renewal inspection was conducted during the afternoon hours. Due to high temperatures, the school-age children were observed participating in activities within the indoor environment.

The children were observed playing catch and kicking balls in the gymnasium. Following the activity, the educator asked the children if they would like to have a picnic snack in the gym where they could remain cool and comfortable. The children were observed gathering mats to sit on and washing their hands prior to eating their snack.

The indoor environment was well organized and included clearly defined learning centers with a wide variety of materials available for the school-age children. Pedagogical documentation incorporating natural materials, written observations, nature-based items, photographs of the children, and indications of future learning opportunities was displayed throughout the classroom. Educators shared that the children are currently interested in art activities, nature exploration, water play, and insects.

The following records were reviewed during the inspection: Incident logs, fire drill records, menus and substitutions, daily attendance records

Child-to-staff ratios were observed to be in compliance throughout the inspection. All required information was appropriately posted on the parent information board.

All staff files were reviewed, and a random sample of children's files was also reviewed.

The inspector discussed opportunities to enhance the materials available in the gymnasium when classroom groups are utilizing the space. Examples included providing access to Lego, art materials, board games, and other age-appropriate resources to support varied learning experiences.

The facility is recommended for licensing.
