The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site in the morning to conduct a monitoring inspection. The child to staff ratio was respected during the inspection.

The following elements were verified:

- Checks
- Staff members records
- Qualifications and training
- Premises
- The outdoor play area and equipment
- Safety
- Transportation

The transportation vehicle was not on site during the inspection. The inspector will verify the vehicle during the renewal inspection.

The Quality Assurance Monitor observed in a staff members' file that the CPR certification was expired. The operator informed the Quality Assurance Monitor that the staff in question is not currently working at this facility and might return in the fall. The operator will verify if the certification is renewed and will send a copy by email to the Quality Assurance Monitor. The CPR certification must be renewed before the staff member returns to work at the facility.

The Quality Assurance Monitor observed the children playing outdoors. The children were drawing on the pave with chalks and with paper and crayons. The children were also observed wearing costumes and engaged in imaginary play. The Quality Assurance Monitor observed the transition to indoors and lunchtime (lunch boxes). After lunch, the children were engaged in drawing a city on big paper, playing with cars and with clay. Positive interactions were observed between the operator and the children.
