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<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Upon arrival of licensing staff, the children were engaged in free play. The operator was sitting on the floor with the children and playing with them. They were building flowers and a jungle. The operator was heard praising the children and commenting on the flowers they made. They then cleaned up and took out magnet tiles. The children were observed building a garage for their monster trucks. The children and operator then cleaned up to go to the playroom. The operator was heard thanking the children as they helped pick up magnets. Once in the playroom, the operator set up a ramp for the children to ramp their monster trucks on. A car mat was also set out on the floor and the children played with their trucks, people and animals. The infant was observed playing with musical instruments and exploring the bins of toys.</p> <p>The children then gathered at the table for snack. The operator helped the children with their snack and got their snowsuits out. After snack, the operator helped the children get dressed and they went outside together. The children were seen going down the slide, playing in the snowbank with their animals from inside, and digging in the snow. The operator redirected the children when needed and initiated a race when it was time to return inside. The operator helped the children take their boots and snowsuits off and the children started playing with their trucks in the playroom. The children wanted to play a little longer before having lunch.</p> <p>The operator is attentive to the children and speaks kindly to them. Resources are accessible to the children on low open shelves. Various materials are available such as cars, blocks, flowers, magnets, action figures, books, music instruments, farm hoppers, ride ons, and a construction table.
