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General Comments The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site in the afternoon to conduct a monitoring inspection. The child to staff ratio was respected. The following elements were verified: - Daily activities - Daily routine - Indoor play area and material - Rest area - Washroom - Storage Space - Diaper changing - If all required documents are posted in a visible place in the facility - Medication - Medication records - Incident records - Health The Quality Assurance Monitor observed a water table in the outdoor play area that was filled with water. The Quality Assurance Monitor discussed with the operator the importance of not having staging water and ensuring that the water table is emptied after each use. The operator emptied the water table and refilled it with fresh water before the children played in the staging water. The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the operator regarding designation requirements. The operator confirmed that the Quality Improvement plan is current and confirmed that the 10 hours of professional learning for this renewal year is almost completed. The Quality Assurance Monitor observed the children playing in the indoor play area. The children were

observed playing music and singing songs with the operator with their letters from their names and with playing scarves. The children were also observed putting on costumes and dancing to music. The transition to go play in the outdoor play area was also observed. Positive interactions were observed between the operator and the children.
