<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing staff arrived at 9am for a monitoring inspection. Upon arriving at the home, no children were present. Licensing staff observed the indoor environment during this time.</p> <p>A large variety of natural materials were observed such as dolls, musical instruments, blocks, and toy animals were observed. The operator had themed books set out throughout the indoor environment near similar play materials to allow for connections. Age-appropriate seating areas were observed along with a foam ball pit and small foam climbing structure for infants. A collection of arts and crafts materials were located on low accessible shelving for the children to engage with. The necessary information such as the daily schedule, license and key contacts was posted near the entrance. The washroom was clean and the children's profiles were complete. Recent artifacts were observed in a "learning stories" binder.</p> <p>Around 10am, a child arrived at the home. The operator was observed greeting the child at the entrance. The operator was observed picking up the child and patting their back to help soothe them after being dropped off by their parent. The operator was observed putting on some light music and singing with the child. The operator was heard consoling and then re-directing the child to reading a book. The operator was observed reading a few books with the child. After, the operator was observed inviting the child to play in the dramatic play kitchen. A variety of kitchen accessories was observed. The operator was observed sitting on the floor near the child and engaged in dramatic play with the child.</p> <p>After some time, the operator was observed sanitizing the table, preparing the child's snack and then washing the child's hands before inviting them to eat. The operator offered a few snacks to the child all while sitting on the floor next to the child. The operator was in touch with the child's needs by offering to wipe the child's nose and morning snacks. The operator was calm and actively engaged in the child's interest and activities.</p>
