Comments: Infant Room: Diaper changing procedure not followed. Hand-washing of children not observed after diaper changing. Consulted Public Health regarding using a cloth under each child during diaper changing, this is replaced for each child and then sanitizing of mat occurs after all children completed, this cannot happen as it does not follow diaper changing procedures.  3 Year old Room: Hand-washing not observed after outside play, children went directly to quiet area to interact with books.  Review hand-washing and diaper changing procedures with all staff.

Comments: Broken toys in after school play area and preschool play area to be thrown out. Rotten fruit in bin in after school outside play area. Broken bins in afterschool play area to be thrown out.

Comments: After school room: Bins to be cleaned accumulating dirt and debris.			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;	39(2)(a)	Oct 11, 2019	
Comments: Locks on cabinets in all rooms where toxic products are kept are "for home use only". These locks to be replaced with other locking mechanisms or toxic products moved and stored in secure area that is inaccessible to the children.
