Ensure surfacing is raked regularly to prevent pooling under structure and spots where surfacing is compacted.

### General Comments

#### Monitoring Inspection:

##### Infant Room:

The learning environment is set up with a variety of purposefully planned invitations that support the children's learning and interests. Materials are displayed in a way that is inviting to the children. The children's many interests are visible through the documentation that is displayed through the room. Educators have added a small easel with watercolour paints to the indoor play area, as well as opportunities to explore watercolours in the outdoor play area. Great work!

##### Twos Room:

The children in this group were engaged in outdoor play this morning. The children were observed exploring healthy risks on the balance beam with encouragement from their educators. The educators have added mark making areas to both the indoor and outdoor environments. Nice touch!

##### Threes Room:

The children in this group were engaged in a variety of activities in the outdoor play area. Many positive interactions were observed during washroom breaks and transitioning to outdoor play. Educators have added materials both indoors and outdoors that support the children's interests in building and houses.

How can you make the outdoor music room more inviting for the children?

##### Fours Room:

Children engaged in a variety of activities both indoors and outdoors this morning. Documentation is displayed that supports the children's interests and learning. Educators have added opportunities for art and mark making outdoors. Great work!

It was observed that the educators in this group respond to the children's ideas by adding materials that will expand on their play and learning. (example adding water - to dirt to create mud, helping children collect shovels for digging, etc.)

##### School-Age Room:

Full day program running today - PD Day.

The children were observed enjoying the sunshine in the outdoor play area. Educators have added materials to the indoor environment that support their interest in space and restaurant.
