Infant Outdoor Play Area:

Tire swing - hanging from two ropes causing an entanglement hazard when twisted. Tire swing must be hung with one rope and secured in a way that prevents entanglement. QA Monitor discussed with the administrator during inspection: that tire swing can not be used until repairs are made. Needs immediate attention.

Wooden platform/bridge - boards loose and screws protruding. To be secured and repaired.

Mud kitchen - broken hooks and screws protruding. To be repaired and broken hooks replaced.

Wooden spools - in poor repair. To be replaced or repaired.

Tonka Truck - broken. To be replaced.

Preschool Outdoor Play Area:

Play structure - screws protruding from side. To be repaired.

Outdoor classroom building - paint chipping. To be painted.

School-Age Outdoor Play Area:

Tire swing - rope is fraying and in poor repair. Tire swing must be hung with one rope and secured in a way that prevents entanglement. QA Monitor discussed with the administrator during inspection; that tire swing can not be used until repairs are made. Needs immediate attention.

Shelter - paint chipping and shingles broken. Shingles to be repaired and painted.

Storage box - screw protruding. To be repaired.

Easel - screw protruding and stand broken. To be repaired.

Picnic tables - paint chipping and in poor repair. Picnic tables to be replaced or repaired.

Stairs - loose/ rotten boards. To be replaced/repaired.

Front steps in poor repair in several places. To be repaired.
