General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on July 18, 2025.

Children were observed during outdoor free play and during the transition to lunch. Proper handwashing was observed as the children transitioned indoors. Steps or platforms were provided in the washroom areas to support children in accessing regular-sized toilets and sinks independently.

Educators shared that the children are currently interested in community outings to the local splash pad and museum. Within the program, the children have been engaged in creating space rockets out of cardboard, exploring an open-ended exploration station, and expressing creativity at a sparkle station for beading.

Positive child guidance techniques were observed throughout the facility. The daily incident log is maintained, and monthly emergency evacuations are completed as required. The daily routine and evacuation procedures were posted and located in visible, prominent locations.

The room was arranged in an inviting manner, with thoughtfully organized materials that encouraged children to engage in play. Several well-defined learning centres were present, including building, reading, dramatic play, and science areas. Traffic paths were clear, and the outdoor walkways were free of clutter and debris.

The changing area was located within one metre of a sink. Diaper changing procedures were clearly posted and visible to staff responsible for diapering routines. Outdoor stationary equipment was surrounded by protective surfacing of appropriate depth, in line with safety requirements. Various forms of documentation were displayed throughout the facility. Educators had completed webs with the children, and these had been thoughtfully expanded upon to reflect ongoing interests and learning.
