General Comments
<p>A Monitoring Inspection was completed this afternoon. Children were observed during free play, and snack time. Free Play – a group of children were observed completing an arts and craft activity, making, and painting green turtles. Others were observed playing in the Dramatic Play area, with dolls and the doll house, and taking part in Costume Play. A group of children were also observed in the Building Center, creating a piano, with Lego. Before snack, children were observed cleaning up their activities, lining up at the door, and walking to the bathroom, to wash their hands. Classroom was set up with several well-defined learning centers, some of which included: building, reading, dramatic play, arts and crafts, and science / mathematics. Positive Child Guidance techniques were observed - educators freely talking to the children, asking them about their school day and their interests. Educators were observed using positive language when interacting with the children, educators were observed preparing the children for transitions, and educators ensured that there was a good balance of activities in the program content. Arts & Crafts - Several examples of cookie cutter crafts were observed throughout the classroom. Although children may enjoy completing this type of artwork, it is strongly recommended that children are provided the opportunity for more open-ended arts and crafts (children using their imaginations to create drawings, paintings, crafts, etc.) Books - Educator stated that children are presently very interested in Dinosaurs. When observing the book center, it was noticed that most of the books were either dinosaur themed and or Lego themed. Educator stated that books are interchanged frequently, based on the interests of the children. It is recommended that several different topics are available and accessible to the children daily.</p>
