Comments: While observing the outside play area, it was observed that the pea gravel surfacing under the swings, was worn down. The surfacing under the swings was minimal, due to the number of children swinging during the school day. A conversation took place with educators regarding surfacing. Before the afterschool children are able to resume using the swings, educators are to ensure that there is enough surfacing. Educators to move some of the access surfacing, under the swings. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments
<p>A Monitoring Inspection occurred on November 20, 2025.</p> <p>The children were observed in both indoor and outdoor environments, including the transition between the two.</p> <p>Indoors: the children were engaged in a variety of activities, including coloring, building with Lego, playing air hockey, working with playdough, and creating with Perler beads alongside their educator. Several children were also observed eating a snack.</p> <p>Outdoors: The children were observed playing on stationary equipment, exploring the wooded area, and drawing with chalk.</p> <p>Educators demonstrated positive interactions by using encouraging language and gentle reminders. They asked open-ended questions, listened actively, and extended children's ideas through conversations.</p> <p>Several forms of documentation were observed, including photographs, and individual and collaborative artwork.</p> <p>A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for posting the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents observed included incident logs, daily attendance records, and monthly emergency evacuation and fire drill records.</p>

General Comments

A conversation took place with the educators regarding the following:

- Educators are to ensure the surfacing under the school's stationary equipment in the outside play area is to be raked daily to ensure the safety of the children. Previously discussed September 8, 2025.
- Educator to ensure a monthly review and maintenance plan is completed on all stationary equipment showing the review and repair dates, the action required and taken, and the name of the staff completing the review.
