Comments: While observing the outside play area, it was observed that the pea gravel surfacing under the swings, was				

worn down. The surfacing under the swings was minimal, due to the number of children swinging during the school day. A conversation took place with educators regarding surfacing.

## **General Comments**

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on November 20, 2025.

The children were observed in both indoor and outdoor environments, including the transition between the two.

Indoors: the children were engaged in a variety of activities, including coloring, building with Lego, playing air hockey, working with playdough, and creating with Perler beads alongside their educator. Several children were also observed eating a snack.

Outdoors: The children were observed playing on stationary equipment, exploring the wooded area, and drawing with chalk.

Educators demonstrated positive interactions by using encouraging language and gentle reminders. They asked open-ended questions, listened actively, and extended children's ideas through conversations.

Several forms of documentation were observed, including photographs, and individual and collaborative artwork.

A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for posting the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents observed included incident logs, daily attendance records, and monthly emergency evacuation and fire drill records.
