General Comments
<p>A monitoring inspection was conducted today.</p> <p>In the Infant room discussed with educators use of "Our Youngest Children" support document. This document has a lot of great ideas for helping educators reflect on their practices as educators who work with infants and young children. Discussed sensory for infant room: IE: Ziploc bags with items inside as well as hair gel/hair conditioner. These are then sealed and the infants are able to explore these with the hands and feet.</p> <p>Discussed with educators in the 3 / 4 year old room child led interests. By observing the children in the block/construction zone we discussed invitations in this area. Adding pictures of real buildings, pictures of construction vehicles at work, clipboard with paper, pencils/markers, adding books of construction vehicles and buildings as well. Recommending the educators refer to the CAT Document:: Valuing Children and Valuing Environments when observing children to see what their interests are and setting up the environments based on their interests.</p> <p>In the 4 year old room the children's current interest is pirates. This came from the interest in Penguins. The educator indicated that a piece of documentation hung on the wall with a map of the world on it led the children to say "it's like a treasure map". The new interest of pirates has emerged from that. The children have created pirate hats and hooks for their hands and have gone on a treasured hunt and were planning another treasure hunt.</p> <p>In both 2 year old rooms and the 3 year old room not a lot of time was spent as the children were preparing to go have their lunch. Children were observed participating in art activities, listening to a story and having a quick dance party before lunch.</p> <p>In all learning environments the educators were observed having meaningful and respectful conversations with the children and getting down their level in play and learning. The children appeared happy and content in their</p>
