### General Comments

A renewal inspection was conducted on May 10, 2023.

Educators and children were very welcoming to the Inspector during the renewal inspection and were eager to show what the children have been learning and changes to their learning environments.

The children were observed during morning snack, outside play, inside free play, lunch and nap/quiet time.

The addition of the infant deck has enhanced the infant room, giving the children and educators access to the outside from their inside learning environment.

Each of the outside play areas have a wide variety of materials for the children to interact and engage with and the children were observed playing with bubbles, climbing, making music on the music wall and laughing with their peers and educators.

In each of the indoor learning environments, the children's learning is documented and displayed in the form of

pictures, captions, learning stories and art. The children's current interests are also displayed in the form of webs, which the educators have added ideas to enhance the children's learning. These ideas were then observed being implemented.

Discussed were had with the Operator and Administrator regarding the correct medication forms to use and the requirements for professional learning of educators.
