General Comments

The children's learning environment is set up based on their interests and the toys and materials are observed to be neatly displayed on shelves and in bins, organized and clean. The staff acknowledged their responsibilities regarding the COVID-19 cleaning and disinfecting protocols.

Evidence of purposeful program planning within each of the rooms. Educators maintain their own binder which includes up-to-date documentation that demonstrates connections made to the NB Curriculum Framework.

In the preschool room, the educator and children were observed to be engaged in activity and comfortable conversation during inspection. The other half of the bubble group were in the outdoor play space. Dividing the bubble group into smaller group activities is a great way to enhance excitement, enthusiasm, cooperation and collaboration. The children in both groups appeared to be very content.

The children are currently bringing their own snacks and lunches.
