<p>General Comments</p> <p>Renewal inspection was completed today. Infant and 2/3 year old groups were enjoying play in the outdoor environment, the preschool children were engaged in group time with an educator ahead of preparing for outdoor play. Educators were observed engaged in play and conversation along side children. Indoor and outdoor environments have an abundance of materials and choice for children.</p> <p>Documentation posted in the learning environments include topic webs, children's art and learning stories. Binders in each room demonstrate recent activities and projects that children have completed, and demonstrates how educators plan activities and invitations to support children's interests.</p> <p>Discussed ensuring that when groups are heading outside for play, attendance records must accompany them.</p>
