## **General Comments**

Monitoring inspection completed today.

Children engaged in play in the indoor and outdoor play areas today. Indoors, dramatic play, blocks, and books were activities children were observed to engage with. Educators were observed participating in play and conversation along side children. Outdoors, creativity, co-operative play and problem solving were observed as children used natural materials (rocks, and grass) while playing in the mud kitchen baking muffins.

Current documentation in portfolios and posted throughout the play environments highlights recent activities and children's learning around interest topics.

As discussed, it is imperative that staff are aware of the number of children present in their group at all times throughout the day.
