Renewal inspection completed today.

Children engaged in indoor and outdoor play during inspection.

The indoor environments are purposefully planned with children having access to all areas and a variety of materials. Materials and documentation reflect children's current interests and recent learning. Forms of documentation included learning stories, webs, photos, descriptions of processes and art work.

Creative art posted throughout all rooms demonstrates educators appreciation for and value of the creative process rather than a product. Preschool children's words are documented alongside their art. When educators document children's words it gives value to their process.

Outdoors a variety of materials were available. Sand, water, cars, kitchen area, bubbles, mark making and painting were activities children were observed engaged with.

Educators responded to children at their level, engaging in conversation and play alongside the children.
