Comments: During review of attendance records. It was noted that at 7:00AM, at opening, there are two children (Infants 0-23 months) and one child (2 years of age). Discussed with educator who indicated that from 7:00-7:15 there is one educator with the three children. Next educator arrives at 7:15 and will then take the 2 year old with her. Discussed with Administrator that this cannot happen, as Infants are not permitted to be mixed with children at any time. Administrator indicated that going forward the educator who is in at 7:15 will come in at 7:00 to ensure that infants are not mixed with other age groups.

It was observed during both morning snack and lunch the educators in all groups sitting with the children engaged in conversations with them.
