Comments: Infant (15-23 month room): * It was observed during nap/quiet time one in the room lying down on their cot with a bottle. Discussed with administrator that this cannot occur. Children can be held while bottle fed or they can sit up to feed to themselves. Original comply by date of October 13, 2022. Administrator had indicated that the educators are trying to have the children give themselves their bottle sitting up but sometimes they lay down. A solution may be that the children are either held while taking their bottle(s) or they remain at the table until their bottle(s) is finished. | 48(4)(b) | Oct 31, 2022 | |
