General Comments				
A Monitoring Inspection occurred June 26, 2025.				
Children were observed during indoor and outdoor free play as well as during snack time. Proper handwashing routines were followed during snack and transitions to indoor spaces. Steps and platforms were in place to help children access regular-sized toilets and sinks. Educators noted that the children are currently showing a strong interest in sensory leaf play, group art activities using paint and loose parts, exploration of various bug species, butterfly life cycles, Alphabet I Spy games, and water play. Outdoors, educators were observed actively engaging with children and supporting their play. Parents are informed of incidents, and incident report forms are completed as required. Outdoor play is provided for at least one hour in every four-hour block when most children are present, weather permitting. The daily routine is displayed visually in each room, and evacuation procedures are posted prominently. The facility had a wide range of age-appropriate toys, books, equipment, and materials available to support learning and development. Diaper changing procedures were visible near change areas, and allergy information for children was clearly posted. Drinking water was accessible throughout the day. The infant outdoor play area was used separately or at different times than those of older children. Outdoor stationary play structures were surrounded by protective surfacing of suitable depth to support safe play. Various forms of documentation were visible throughout the facility, including webs that had been coconstructed with children and further expanded by educators.
