CD player cord has been affixed to the wall within preschool room but another cord was pointed out in the 2/3s room today that was not. Inspector requested that cord be affixed to the wall or removed to ensure safety. Previous comply by date of July 23/21.

Comments: The creative art shelf within the 2/3 year old room lacked variety today. Materials were added from storage room materials based on recommendations of inspector. Inspector modelled how these should be set up in an inviting way to encourage open ended art. This must be maintained and replenished daily. Previous comply by date June 30/21.

32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (b) arranged on low, open shelves and accessible to the children receiving services at the licensed facility, Comments: Creative art materials were not accessible to the children within the 2/3 year old room today, as they were on a shelf out of the children's reach. Inspector modelled how these materials should be set up on low open shelving and accessible to the children daily. Only some creative art materials were accessible within the preschool room and other materials are being stored in a closed cupboard. Ensure these are accessible at all times to the children to explore as they wish. Previous comply by date of June 30/21.	32(1)(b)	Aug 31, 2021

Follow up to renewal inspection completed today. Some orders have been rectified but outstanding orders for compliance remain. Discussed outstanding orders with administrator and director.

Licence will not be renewed at this time due to outstanding orders for compliance. Another follow up inspection is required. Director must ensure that children who are 2 years of age are moved out of the infant room as soon as space becomes available, and not accept any more enrollments for this room until these spaces have been secured.
