<p>Comments: Twos Room (Back Room): Art materials depleted. Plain white paper, glue, age appropriate scissors, paint and paint brushes not accessible. To be added. Playdough accessories accessible. However, playdough not accessible. To be added.</p> <p>Threes Room (Front Room): Easel set up without materials. Easel to be set up with materials. Example: Whiteboard markers, paint, paintbrushes, rollers, paper, chalk, etc.</p> <p>Fours Room (Middle Room): Easel set up without materials. Easel to be set up with materials. Example: Whiteboard markers, paint, paintbrushes, rollers, paper, chalk, etc. Materials depleted throughout room, due to cleaning. Materials must be accessible to children. Children must have a variety materials accessible during indoor play. Discussed with educators - ensure that materials are rotated for cleaning or cleaning of materials happens when children are resting/outside. Two dolls accessible without accessories. During inspection it was observed that the children were interested in the baby dolls. However, there were insufficient baby dolls and accessories for the amount of children enrolled. Examples of materials to include, but are not limited to: dolls, diapers, bibs, bottles, bed, diaper bag, blankets, dishes, etc.</p> <p>Each environment lacking in materials that support the children's current interests. Ensure materials are added that support the multiple interests of the children. Examples of materials to include, but are not limited to: interest based books, art materials, dramatic play props, etc</p>

<p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Rooms have been reconfigured since last Monitoring Inspection. Change in Service Application was submitted to remove infants from license. QA Monitor approved changes. Current Room Arrangement: Threes Room - Front Room Fours Room - Middle Room Two/Threes Room - Back Room</p> <p>Children observed engaged in mark making, story time and outdoor play this morning. Documentation is posted throughout the facility that supports the children's learning and experiences. Discussed with educators moving documentation down to children's eye level. This will give the children the opportunity to revisit their experiences.</p> <p>Discussed with educators in Fours Room ways to encourage children to explore materials in different ways. Example - encouraging children when exploring scissors on materials like playdough, cardboard, materials from nature and yarn.</p> <p>Hand washing routines observed. New staff file review - all documents in place.</p>
