Comments: Diaper changing procedure was not followed. Disinfectant spray did not remain on change surface for required 2 minutes. procedure was discussed with educator at time of inspection. Recommendation made to have staff regularly review the diaper changing procedure.

Comments: Trim at base of siding at back of building broken and sharp. Must be replaced. Base of door rusted and paint peeling. Must be scraped and repainted.

Comments: Cleaning products in kitchen cupboard under sink not secured by lock and key. Bathroom disinfectant spray on open shelf in bathroom is a toxic product and must be locked. As discussed during inspection, Toxic products must be secured by lock and key.			

<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Renewal Inspection completed today.</p> <p>Throughout the indoor play areas, creative art, blocks, small manipulatives, puzzles, and dramatic play areas are set up with materials displayed at the children's level and easily accessible. Preschool Room- Ensure pencil crayons are sharpened.</p> <p>Through art work documented with children's words, learning stories, portfolios, webs, and photos, children's interests and current learning are demonstrated and posted in the learning environments.</p>
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General Comments

Children were observed during outdoor play, lunch and preparing for quiet time/nap time. Outdoors children engaged in group and individual play with materials available, including ride on toys, balls, buckets, natural stumps and balance beam. Educators were observed to engage with children in conversation and play.

Handwashing was observed when children returned to the centre from outdoor play. During diaper changing, the educator was observed to engage in conversation with the child listening attentively as the child spoke, and asking questions.
