Monitoring Inspection:

Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including an art activity, outdoor play, dramatic play, block building, and "cooking" in the mud kitchen.

Educators observed encouraging children to explore healthy risks in the outdoor play area as they balanced and climbed on the outdoor play equipment.

QA Monitor discussed with educators ways to help with transition times, rather than waiting for children to line up and stand quietly try each educator asking a small group of children to join them to go inside and wash their hands.

QA Monitor discussed with staff adding more natural materials to environments and photos of real-life items within the new environment.

Hand washing routines observed.

Bagels with cream cheese were served for morning snack.

Pizza and kiwi were served for lunch.
