General Comments
A follow-up inspection was conducted on July 8, 2026, to review previously identified areas of non-compliance. Licensing confirmed that the non-compliance related to contact information has been corrected and is now compliant. The non-compliance related to Social Development Record Checks for board members remains outstanding. The administrator advised that the required checks have been submitted and are currently pending. Once the

results are received, the administrator will notify Licensing. This item will be reviewed again during the next follow-up inspection.

Licensing also observed that the outdoor gate remains difficult to open. The administrator indicated that arrangements have been made for repairs; however, the work has not yet been completed. Once the gate has been repaired and is functioning properly, Licensing will reassess and determine compliance for this item.

Licensing will conduct another follow-up inspection within approximately two weeks to review the outstanding items. The administrator was advised to contact Licensing if additional time is required to address the remaining areas of non-compliance.
