Comments: Infant Room - Diaper changing routine observed. Sanitizing spray was used but staff did not wait the required 2 minutes before wiping change pad. Staff to review diaper changing procedures. Discussed with staff during time of inspection. Plant dome box within preschool room appears to be growing mildew and requires a change in soil.

Comments: Three's room: Additional materials required for dolls (accessories / clothes) to support dramatic play.

Comments: Infant Room: Mark making materials (ex: crayons, paper) were not noted within the infant room environment during time of inspection. Ensure these materials are accessible to the children daily to explore.

Comments: Threes room - Little People car track collecting dust/debris. To be cleaned. Some books to be repaired/replaced. Crib in dramatic play area needs cleaned. Lid on garbage can to be fixed / replaced. Square wooden table within dramatic play area to be repaired (one leg is loose).

Comments: Kitchen door was left open during time of inspection. Kitchen doors should remain closed at all times.

Comments: Kitchen -Toxic products were found underneath the sink within the kitchen. These products should be locked by lock and key or a CSA approved lock.			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (b) medications.	39(2)(b)	Nov 22, 2021	
Comments: Tylenol was found within two's room in upper cupboard with a child lock. Medications must be locked under lock and key or a CSA approved lock. These could also be moved to the operators office where there is a lock on the office door.			

General Comments

Renewal inspection completed today.
Hand washing routines and diaper changing routines were observed.
The children were observed during indoor play, during lunch time and rest time.
Educators were noted to be engaged and interacting with the children at their level throughout the facility.
Interests were noted throughout the rooms in the form of documentation, creative art, webs, and charts.
Some of the interests at this time included farm animals, colors, and the alphabet. Photos of the children and their experiences related to the curriculum are also posted within the foyer area for parents and children to review and revisit.
Children on site with extreme allergies have an Extreme Allergy Management Plan completed and this is being stored with required medications and Epipens within the room. Educators were well informed of children with allergies.
