General Comments
<p>A renewal inspection occurred today.</p> <p>The children were observed in the inside and outside environments. The educators were observed having meaningful conversations with the children, listening carefully allowing them time to think and express how they are feeling. Licensing observed flexible areas that are rich in opportunities for sensory learning, social interaction, language, exploration, manipulation, and representation. They are purposely designed and planned to enhance children's healthy development and learning.</p> <p>Infants room had a wide variety of materials for infants to explore. Art materials were accessible to the infants. Educators were observed singing, reading, and playing with the infants.</p> <p>Twos room had family photos displayed on wall that reflected each child's familiar home environment. Documentation displayed was current and reflects the children's current learning interest. The alphabet was displayed around the room in multiple ways such as pictures of each letter using natural materials as well as in sign language.</p> <p>Threes room had learning stories reflective of children's previous experiences that give children an opportunity to revisit their thinking and creations. Natural materials and loose parts displayed neat and tidy, ready for the children to create with.</p> <p>Fours room had labelled materials in child print to help children with maintenance and care. Current learning was evident in the classroom. Real blueprint with children's blueprints displayed on the wall supports the children's current learning interest of building.</p> <p>During lunch time children were observed serving themselves. The open concept gives children the opportunity to make choices about when, what, and how much they want to eat. Serving themselves allows children control over the amount they take and gives them practice with pouring and carrying food and drink. They are also able to say "no" when they are not hungry, an important concept in learning about the relationship between food and their bodies.</p> <p>Discussed diaper changing procedures with staff and administrator. Recommending administrator reach out to Public Health for clarification.</p> <p>Diaper changing, hand washing, and nap time observed.</p> <p>All staff files and random review of child files completed.</p>
