<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection COVID-19 Recovery Phase.</p> <p>Observed screening procedures for staff at entry to the building. Signage and one way arrows are posted throughout the building. Completed a random review of the group log forms and those reviewed were completed properly.</p> <p>Cleaning checklists and procedures were posted and discussed. Ensure that bins and toy shelves are also being cleaned/disinfected with the toys.</p> <p>The environment in both classrooms were reflective of current interests with documentation in the form of art work, mobiles, charts, webs, books the children have made themselves and open ended questions. The addition of the plastic sheet protectors to interchange each child's creations/art work is a great addition to the environment and protects their work, thereby valuing their creations.</p> <p>The children were observed playing outdoors and are reportedly spending a lot of time outside. There is a schedule in place for outdoor time to ensure that everyone is able to get outside at any time that they wish, which promotes flexibility, while also ensuring proper distancing between groups of children.</p> <p>Ensure all Epipens are accompanied by Emergency Allergy Management Plan (Appendix 4) and that both of</p>
