General Comments

A renewal inspection occurred today. Upon arrival at the childcare facility, all children were observed heading for a special outing to O'Connell Park for the morning. Inspector remained at the centre with the Operator and inspected the childcare environments.

All staff files were reviewed and verified by Inspector.

A random review of children's files occurred and were verified complete.

When the children arrived back the childcare faciltyl they were observed having lunch, preparing for afternoon snack and outside play.

In each of the learning environments children's learning is documented and displayed using webs, art, learning stories, pictures/captions. Documentation was observed displayed down at the level of the children, making it easier for them to revisit their experiences.

During lunch, the inspector observed, the educators sitting with the children engaged in conversations with them and asking them open ended questions.

In the indoor learning environments, it was observed by the Inspector, that defined interest centers with ageappropriate materials for the children to interact and engage were available: art, dramatic play, book centre, blocks/ building, and sensory were available for all the children to interact and engage with.

Children were also observed in the outside play area engaged in water play, riding cars, climbing and playing in the sandbox.
