Comments: Upon arrival at the childcare facility, the Inspector observed in the downstairs 2–3-year-old rooms that the children were being grouped together as one group instead of two. Ratio was taken and it exceeded						
maximum group size for two educators. Three educators were supervising a group of twelve children: 8 children 2 years of age and 4 children 3 years of age and these children were free flowing between the two rooms. This exceeds maximum group size and ratio for two educators. Discussed with Operator and Educators during inspection that the maximum group size for two educators cannot be exceeded. Discussed with Operator and Educators ratios for maximum group size as per the Act and Regulations. Groups are to be divided into two separate groups.

Comments: Inspector reviewed the mandatory attendance records and observed that the two-year-old group and three-year-old group were on the same attendance records as they were grouped together as one large group with three educators. Discussed with Operator and Educators ratio, maximum group size and two sets of attendance records are required for the children that must be divided into two groups.

General Comments

A monitoring inspection occurred. Children were observed during lunch, transitioning to outside play and outside afternoon play.

Ratio was taken and was discussed with the Operator maximum group size, ratios and Inspector offered suggestions as to best support the Educators to ensure maximum group size is being maintained with two educators as well as how to best support educator, so they do not feel like they are working alone. Suggestions such as leaving the door open between the two rooms and adding a gate so the one educator in the room alone with the children would not feel isolated but would have the support of the other two educators in the other room in case of diapering/washroom incidents.

Children were observed participating in active conversation with their educators during lunch and were observed being encouraged to open their own snacks but were helped if they required the assistance in opening their snacks/lunch.

In the outside play area, the children were observed by the Inspector climbing on the logs, riding bikes, playing with trucks. Children told the Inspector about their morning outing to O'Connell Park and what they had observed. Children also told the Inspector about the hot air balloons that were observed earlier in the day. A new staff members file was reviewed and verified completed.
