General Comments
<p>Monitoring Inspection COVID-19 Recovery Phase:</p> <p>Children engaged in outdoor play this afternoon. Positive interactions observed between educators and children.</p> <p>Environments have been rearranged into two groups; each group has their own entrance/exit, washroom, indoor play area and outdoor play area.</p> <p>It is evident staff have been frequently cleaning play area, high touch areas, washrooms and toys. A cleaning schedule has been created and is implemented well.</p> <p>All toys that are not easily cleaned have been removed. Each child has their own art supply pouch and bag of Lego in their cubby.</p> <p>Hand washing routines were observed today.</p>

General Comments

Ensure that First Aid Kit and attendance are brought outside to the outdoor play area. This can be a smaller First Aid Kit that is stocked with frequently used First Aid supplies. See section 10.8 of Operator's Manual under what you need to know.
