<p>General Comments</p> <p>A Monitoring Inspection was completed this morning.</p> <p>2's Room, 107 B – Children were getting ready to go outside. Children were observed getting their coats on and lining up at the door. The classroom had several learning invitations ready for the children. In the Art Centre, Large white paper covered a table, and the children's morning artwork was observed.</p> <p>3's Room, 108 – Children were outside during today's inspection. The room was set up with several different learning invitations, and documentation was observed throughout the space. There was an "All About Me" area within the classroom that had activities and documentation relating to Emotions, Hair Color, Eye Color, Families, etc.</p> <p>4's Room, 104 B - Children were observed playing at the Water Centre, building with Lego, stacking plastic flowerpots, and playing with Babies. Children were also observed playing in the play kitchen area, making delicious meals, for their guest. Educators were observed sitting with and engaging with the children. A display of airplanes and helicopters were posted on the wall.</p> <p>4's Room, 105 B - A group of children were observed sitting at a table, playing with Play Doh. Others were observed in the Dramatic Play area, playing with the kitchen and pretend food. Some children were observed making and enjoying music, in the Music Centre. Educators were engaged with the children, sitting with, asking questions, and taking part in play. Children were observed washing their hands before snack. Today's snack was yogurt and crackers. Children's interests were very evident throughout the classroom – A paper mâché solar system was observed, as was several different forms of documentation relating to different Planets and Astronauts. Cultures from all around the world, were also displayed, and children were learning how to say "Hello" in different languages.</p>
