A Monitoring Inspection was completed this afternoon. Children were observed during free play, snack time, and					

A Monitoring inspection was completed this alternoon. Children were observed during free play, shack time, and during hand washing procedures. Classrooms were set up with several well-defined learning centers, some of which included the following: building and transportation, books, dramatic play, arts and crafts, and gross motor (slides and yoga). Positive Child Guidance techniques were observed in all classrooms – educators were observed giving gentle reminders, offering choices, anticipating children's needs, redirecting negative behaviors, using positive language when interacting with children, and respecting children's feelings. Several forms of documentation were observed throughout the classrooms. Examples of documentation included but were not limited to the following: learning stories, children's artwork, and word webs. 2's Room – Children were observed finishing up their snacks. After snack, children were observed washing their hands. 3's Room – Children were observed sliding, building, completing arts and crafts, and looking at books. A group of children were also observed in the yoga center, doing yoga. Children were observed laughing, smiling, and following along to yoga flash cards, that their educator was presenting. 3 / 4 Room – A group of children were observed sitting at a table, completing arts and crafts. One little one was observed painting at the easel. Others were observed building with magnetic tiles. Carrots and flowers were observed growing on the windowsill. 4 / 5 Room – Children were very excited to see QAM. A group of children took QAM around the room, showing QAM their favorite activities. When children arrived, hand washing procedures were observed.
