General Comments

Name of operator

A Monitoring Inspection occurred this morning. Children were observed in the indoor play area eating snack or engaged in free play.

Ropewalk Room-Children were observed engaged with educators in sensory play with sand, painting at an easel and tabletop activities. Documentation of science exploration linked to the NBCF was present on the wall next to Tuff Tray.

Churchill Room-Children were observed eating snack, rolling toy cars down a handmade cardboard ramp, and in puppet play. Documentation included multiple artwork samples displayed on the wall and children's portfolios displayed up to date pedagogical documentation.

Somerset Room-Children were observed engaged in water play, imaginary play in the play kitchen and building with loose parts. Documentation was present on the wall reflecting an interest in the signs of spring.

General Comments

MacLaren Room-Children were observed engaged in sensory play in a bin of natural loose parts and dinosaur toys and transitioning to the outdoors. Documentation was observed as learning stories on the wall based on their current interest in pirates and the pirate ship created by educators.

Children went for a walk outside. Outdoor play area was observed, children were not present. A small area of fencing was recently damaged and is currently under repair by a third party (Fundy Fencing).

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
