A monitoring inspection occurred in the morning.

Churchill Room: The children were observed outdoors engaged in a variety of activities that included water play, riding bikes, using the slide, playing with cars and trucks, climbing on tires, and playing with robots. The educator indicated that the children are currently interested in robots, outdoor play, and sensory activities, specifically painting.

Ropewalk Room: The children were not observed, as they were not at the facility at the time of the inspection. The room and documentation were observed, including a "worm" learning web and a "honeybee" learning web, along with ongoing documentation that corresponded with the learning webs. Children's artwork and individual learning story books were observed.

Maclaren Room: The children were not observed, as they were not at the facility at the time of the inspection. The room and documentation were observed, including a "Chicka Chicka Boom Boom" learning Web and a "sea" learning web, with ongoing documentation that corresponded with the learning webs. Children's artwork and individual learning story books were also observed.

Somerset Room: The children were not observed, as they were not at the facility at the time of the inspection. The room and documentation were observed, including "Celebrating our Culture" learning web and "bugs" learning web, with ongoing documentation that corresponded with the learning webs. Children's artwork and individual learning story books were also observed.

A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for the posting of the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documentation reviewed included incident logs, daily attendance records, seven educator files, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.

A conversation took place with the administrator on the following:

- Purposeful planning was not evident in the Churchill room. Purposeful planning must be visible through
