<p>A monitoring inspection was conducted on July 22, 2021. Not all outstanding orders for compliance were rectified. The expectation is that all are completed by comply by date.</p> <p>Discussed with administrator that educators, when asked, should know the number of children that are in their care without referring to the attendance records.</p> <p>Discussed the tracking of outside time to ensure children are going outside for a minimum of two hours per day. This is being done and appears to be working.</p> <p>Discussed the new fence that is going to be installed and QAM will inspect on next monitoring visit.</p> <p>Discussed with administrator the use of water/nerf guns. Referred admin to the document "Bang, Bang, Gun Play" to review with educators. Also, having the educators sit down with the children to come up with rules.</p> <p>Children are capable and competent learners and having meaningful conversations with them regarding proper use of water/nerf guns prior to using them will be beneficial. Children seem to follow rules regarding play if they make them themselves and are more accountable for them.</p>
