## **General Comments**

A Monitoring Inspection occurred September 10, 2025

The children were observed engaging in a variety of activities in the outdoor environment, including using the climbing dome and climbing wall, digging in the dirt, playing with flowers, singing, and eating lunch.

Two children were observed napping indoors. Rest periods meet individual needs and do not exceed two consecutive hours.

The outdoor environment featured various gardens where vegetables and flowers were being grown, offering children opportunities to explore nature. The area was equipped with age-appropriate, functional materials in sufficient quantity to encourage children to be active and engaged.

All classrooms were thoughtfully arranged with materials that invite children to play. Several forms of documentation were visible in the indoor environment, including learning stories, photographs, and both individual and collaborative artwork created by the children. These reflect ongoing learning.

A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for posting the facility's license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documentation observed included incident logs, daily attendance

records, one new staff file, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.
