Comments: Medications stored within the washroom cabinet in between the critters and bees room is not locked in a way that is inaccessible. Chain on cupboard to be replaced with chain that has less slack, or to be replaced with an alternative locking mechanism. Medications to be moved out of this cupboard until lock is replaced. Medication within the fridge was unlocked during today's inspection. Lock box to be used for medication that is required to be refrigerated.

<p>Completed renewal inspection today. Educators were engaged with the children throughout all of the rooms. Children were observed during outdoor play, eating lunch, and during quiet/nap time. Educators were observed to be responsive to the children, and supporting communication and literacy by reading to the children and playing music based on the children's mood and interest.</p> <p>The children were observed to be enjoying themselves playing outdoors within the snow this afternoon., engaging with one another, sliding and building with snow. The children follow an outdoor play schedule to ensure that all children are able to spend adequate time outdoors, while ensuring that proper social distancing between groups is maintained.</p> <p>Topics of interest within the rooms (ex: exploring properties of colors, dinosaurs, etc.) were evident with</p>

documentation and materials available to explore.

It is evident that materials and toys within the environment are being cleaned routinely, and that the washrooms are also being cleaned frequently. The washrooms are being shared between the critters and the bees room. Discussed cleaning schedule with the educators, who report that they have scheduled their daily routine around each others groups to maintain social distancing. The washrooms have designated toilets/sinks for each group of children and if other stalls/sinks are needed, the educators are cleaning/sanitizing the washroom between groupings. The children appeared very familiar with their daily routine during today's inspection.
