Comments:	During the renewal inspection the attendance records in each room were reviewed. It was observed that during nap time a child in the 3-year-old room has been going to the Infant Room (15-23 Months) to sleep. This is not permitted, as infants cannot be mixed with preschool age children during the hours of 8:30am to 4: 30pm. Discussed with Administrators and Educator during inspection. Discussed a solution so child(ren) who require naps can still have them.

Comments: During the inspection it was observed and after discussions with Educators, that the children in the 3-year-old room and the 4-year-old room were going outside from 7:30am-8:30am and then again from 3:30pm-4:30pm. This does not follow regulations that requires children to be outside for at least one hour in each four-hour block of time when the majority of the children are there. Discussed with Administrators and Educators during inspection and a change of daily routine to occur to ensure that all the children have the opportunity to go outside every day.								

General Comments

A renewal inspection occurred today.

Discussed with Administrators Professional Learning that is required by Educators. PL Hours completion follows licensing a year, for facility it is from March 1-February 28. The expectation is that Educators have their 10 Hours of PL completed by the license expiration each year.

Discussions were had in regard to outside play time and mixing infants with preschool age children.

The children were observed during morning snack, inside free play time, circle/story time, lunch and nap/quiet time. Diaper changing and handwashing was also observed occurring serving times throughout the inspection. In each of the learning environments there is a wide variety of materials for the children to interact and engage with.
