General Comments
<p>A renewal inspection was conducted today.</p> <p>Educators observed interacting and engaging with the children during snack and lunch. Educators observed having meaningful, respectful conversations with the children during free play and group activities. A variety of materials are available for the children to interact with. Children appeared happy and content in their environment. Lots of literacy displayed throughout the preschool age rooms with bins labelled with both words and pictures.</p> <p>School-age children have a variety of materials to interact and engage with. Children have developed the routine of when they arrive they immediately hang up their outwear wear and wash their hands. Great to see this happening. Educators observed interacting positively with the children and have engaging conversations with them. Discussed with after school educator keeping the planning of activities they do for the school-age program in a binder as these will be asked for during monitoring and renewal inspections.</p> <p>Children's interests are documented and displayed on the wall as well as in their individual portfolios. Discussed with educators keeping markers that have dried out as they can be used in the snow.</p> <p>Discussed ensuring as soon as a new staff is hired that proof of enrollment/waitlist for curriculum training is in the staff's file.</p>
