## **General Comments**

Completed follow up to renewal inspection today.

Children have transitioned into both the jellyfish and lady bug rooms this week. Educators report that these transitions have gone well.

The school age children are now attending full days for the summer and have recently collaborated with their educators to plan activities based on their interests for the upcoming summer. Educator reported that the children shared their ideas and interests and made a calendar incorporating these ideas.

The children were observed during outdoor play and lunch time today. Hand washing routines occurred upon entering from outside.

Discussed rest time routines with one educator and supervisor and that non napping children from the jellyfish room can join the group within the ladybugs room, provided that they do not exceed maximum group size within the room. Also discussed the option of taking half or all of the group outdoors during this time as well. This would provide an undisturbed area for napping children.

Children within the jellyfish room were observed to be engaged in open ended art today using a variety of

creative art materials. Materials within the art center included: safety scissors, glue, colored paper, yarn, large pom poms, foam letters/pieces, pine cones, markers, stamps, and popsicle sticks.

Since groupings have just changed, interests are currently evolving, but the jellyfish room is currently exploring butterflies and the lady bugs have recently explored transportation.

The school aged room has been opened up to allow the children to freely circulate the room (rather than half of the room). Some areas still require additional organization and care as clutter has accumulated throughout this process.

Improvements were noted today with purposeful planning. Recommending for quality assurance monitor to continue to support purposeful planning/implementation of activities related to the children's interests.

Recommending for renewal.
