General Comments
<p>A Monitoring Inspection occurred May 6, 2025.</p> <p>Lady Bug Room: The children were observed eating snack. Hand washing procedures were followed. The snack observed was bananas and tortilla bread. The children were observed engaged in a fish sensory tuff tray, open ended art and painting. The educator indicated the current interests are: bugs, walking adventures, and flowers. Educator indicated the children noticed that the flowers are now growing and to further their interest they planted grass inside the classroom.</p> <p>Butterflies: The children were observed engaged in a science experience with colored water and white roses. Some children were observed cutting the stems and the leaves from the roses. The educator indicated the children's interest is music; to further their exposure to music the educators added a song wall.</p> <p>Barn Yard Critters: The children were observed reading stories and building with the Lego blocks. The educator indicated the children are currently interested in book, puzzle, letters and the changes outside.</p> <p>School-Age: The children were observed in various activities inside and outside. Outside the children were observed using skipping ropes. Bikes, balls, using the climbing structure and reading. Inside the classroom the children were observed engaged in imaginative play and open-ended art.</p> <p>Various forms of documentation were observed throughout the facility, such as, learning stories, photos, family walls, birthday walls, individual portfolios and classroom portfolios. The following administrators records were observed: incident logs, fire drills and attendance records were complete. A conversation occurred with the administrator about the strengths and needs of the facility. Noteworthy strengths were the documentation throughout the facility, the cleanliness of the hallways and high traffic areas, and multiple examples of open-ended art with a variety of materials.
